## **Message from the Chairman**

Welcome to winter edition of the Parish Council's newsletter and a happy new year to you all.

After lengthy discussion and much consideration, Ilkley Parish Council has taken the decision to increase the precept for 2017/18 to £252,325.00. A Band D household in Ilkley currently pays £26.00 per year to fund the important and valuable work of the Parish Council. This will rise to £3 per month. So a family of four in one household will pay only 17p per person per week in total.

The Council has taken the difficult decision to make this increase in order to protect Ilkley's facilities and services from the cuts that have been announced by Bradford Council. Bradford Council are currently proposing to close all public toilets in the town, close the Visitor Information Centre and reduce flower bed planting as well as reducing other services such as street cleansing. As a Council we have rejected these proposals and are doing everything we can to stop these closures.

The Parish Council precept is the only fund that is spent entirely in and for Ilkley and the Parish Council feels that it offers excellent value especially when you consider almost £30 per week is paid in Council Tax directly to Bradford Council by each Band D household. Its fourteen Councillors are all volunteers and do not receive an allowance. The Council is already responsible for the public toilets at White Wells and for Darwin Gardens.

We have recently used the precept to fund the employment of a Town Centre Warden who has carried out some great work on our streets to ensure that they stay clean and tidy for residents and visitors alike.



The Parish Council also makes many awards to local not-for-profit organisations through its Awards and Projects Committee and holds some fantastic annual community events such as the Christmas Lights switch on. The Parish Council funds the Jubilee Lights and Christmas Lights entirely from the precept too.

By agreeing its budget for 2017-18, the Parish Council will continue to make significant contributions to the life and fabric of our wonderful town.

## **Ilkley Parish Council becomes Dementia Friendly**

Ilkley Parish Council have achieved membership of Bradford & District Dementia Action Alliance. Cllrs Jac Rickard, Libby Packett and Brian Mann submitted an action plan to show how IPC are working to become Dementia Friendly, and support Ilkley to become a Dementia Friendly Community. They are committed to raising awareness and understanding of dementia, to reduce the fear and stigma that dementia can hold and support those living with dementia and their families in Ilkley & District to live as well as possible. Cllrs are attending the free monthly public sessions at Clarke Fole to become Dementia Friends and encourage all the community to do so. National Dementia Awareness Week takes place in May, when the group Dementia Friendly Ilkley Action, with the support of the Parish Council, will co-ordinate activities in the town to promote awareness, understanding, and support to continue to work to making Ilkley more Dementia Friendly in 2017.

## **Parish Council Awards and Funding News**

This year the Parish Council's Awards and Projects Committee has made an award to Ilkley Town Football Club of £9,561 to purchase new equipment for the fantastic new 3G pitch at Ben Rhydding Sports Club which will benefit a very large number of children in our community. The new pitch will not just be used by the Football Club, but Ilkley Hockey Club players and Ilkley Harriers athletics club will also benefit from the new facilities.

The Awards Committee also awarded funding to Ashlands Primary School to plant new trees in their playground (pictured below) as part of the schools overall playground improvement scheme.



The Community Fund Committee has funded an extremely valuable counselling service for pupils Ilkley Grammar School. The school does not receive any funding from the Local Education Authority or from central government to help students suffering with mental health issues. This new service will help to diagnose and help students manage their conditions in both an education and home environment. The Community Fund Committee continues to maintain the public toilet block at White Wells and has also funded several Public Access Defibrillators. These are now located at the Riverside Hotel, Booths Supermarket and Ilkley Lido.

The Council is working very hard to save Ilkley's public toilets and Visitor Information Centre and is currently in talks with Bradford Council. Finally, the Council's Town Centre Warden, Darren Secker, is now in post and working hard to keep our town looking clean and tidy for residents and visitors alike.

### **Two Rivers Bands**

The Two Rivers Bands aim to bring the joy of music right to the heart of the local community here in Ilkley. The Concert Band plays a wide variety of wind music including classical and more popular pieces. The Swing Band mixes big band jazz with rock & roll and a touch of Latin. Last year the Concert Band played for Ilkley Arts Festival, for Yorkshire Day, and on Ilkley Bandstand. The Swing Band hosted popular dances, and played at the Ribble Valley Jazz Festival, the Ilkley Queen's birthday celebrations. Both bands have raised large amounts for charity.

They are always on the lookout for enthusiastic players of all ages. There are no entry requirements or auditions. Church on Saturday 29th April. The next Swing Band dance on Saturday 25th March at the Shipley and District Social Club promises to be a great night. Band chairman Phil Chapman said, "We're really proud of how much progress both our bands have made. Come and listen.
