Public Participation at Parish Council Meetings

Did you know that members of the public and press are entitled by law to attend all meetings of the Parish Council? Early on in each meeting there is a Public Participation slot at which any member of the public is able to speak about an item on the agenda. Individuals are able to speak for a maximum of five minutes. Agendas are published three working days prior to each meeting and can be viewed on the Parish Council's website or in the notice board outside the Town Hall.

Allotment Gardens Report

The Parish Council's Bridge Lane, Castle Road and Leeds Road Allotment Gardens have benefitted from excellent growing conditions this year. The warm weather and evening rain have ensured that almost every plot has good produce. had some Blackberries, raspberries, currants, apples, plums, pears and a number of root vegetables have all seemed to do well. We had some absolutely fantastic displays of flowers on one of our plots which you can see above.

The Parish Council's Project Manager for allotments, Councillor Andrew Walbank, does however maintain regular attendance and carries out quarterly inspections along with his Deputy Project Manager, Councillor Websdale or the Clerk. A small number of plots, unfortunately, do not seem to have been well used this year. We have a waiting list of almost 200 and there

are at the moment just over 120 tenants. There is also a need to ensure hazardous materials such as metal, tyres and loose wire netting are not brought on to the sites.

There is a continued programme of maintenance and improvements being carried out as funds allow. Fortunately, with the last mild winter only two water repairs were necessary this year. All additional improvements are funded from the revenue derived from the allotment rent and thanks are due to those tenants who regularly pay their bill and return their tenancy agreements at the beginning of the season in April.

We look forward to autumn when the ground can be prepared for next years' planting and hopefully a good growing season. For more information about allotments in Ilkley please see the website or contact the Clerk on 01943 436212.

The Manor House

Ilkley's Manor House Museum has now been officially designated as an 'Asset of Community Value'. This means that the building can't be sold without a six week consultation taking place beforehand.

The request to list this building as an asset of value was made by Ilkley Civic Society.

Another step forward for the threatened museum has been Bradford Council's agreement to fund a feasibility study. Earlier this year, Bradford Council announced that it would withdraw its funding in Spring 2015 and plans are now in place to hand the management of the over to museum community scheme in April. The study is key in assessing the needs and financial viability of the building.
